Beautiful Birds to Watch

This is the right time of year to be thinking of putting up bird boxes for our visitors. Putting them up by February is still early enough to catch the initial scouting for nesting spots by those birds who like bird boxes. Go to www.allaboutbirds.org for great information on building, placing and or taking care of bird boxes. Once you are on this website, click on “Bird Basics” and then click on “Attract Birds”.

For bird watching, there is a great website you can set as a favorite: www.allaboutbirds.org. The “Cornell Feeder Watch” site found on the allaboutbirds.org site was very active this morning!

The other item I wanted to mention is about the annual Great Backyard Bird Count. It happens the week of February 14th through the 17th and anyone can participate. The basic idea is that you watch birds at one or more locations for at least 15 minutes, one or more days that week. Then you go online and submit your results. It is fun to think that you are

contributing to science in this little way!

Whatever the fascination, it's not too early to get your bird watching, feeding, nesting plans underway.
