The Seahawk logo was based on a Native American Ceremonial Mask:

The designers for the Seattle Seahawks logo were inspired by native Northwest Coast art, specifically settling on a Kwakwaka'wakw [transformation mask](#). 

The mask's similarities to the Seattle Seahawks logo went unnoticed while at the Hudson Museum because it was always featured in an open position, showing the human face inside rather than the "thunderbird."
